Schedule Format Guide

ADULT: 4 games per team

- **Mens Open Gold:** 8 teams, 2 pools. Each team plays 2 pool games to determine playoff seeds. Each team plays 2 playoff bracket games to determine final places.
- **Mens Open Silver:** 16 teams, 4 pools of 4, standard bracket play. Each team will play 4 bracket games to determine final standings.
- Mens 25+: 9 teams, 3 pools. All teams will play 2 pool games to determine playoff seeding. Playoff brackets are three-way brackets to determine winner vs. standard championship game. Each team will play 2 games to determine final standings. Tie breakers will come in to play.
- Mens 30+: 12 teams, 3 Pools of 4 teams. All teams will play 2 Pool games to determine seedings for the Playoff round*. All teams will play 2 Playoff games to determine final standings.
- **Mens 35+:** 8 teams, 2 pools. Each team plays 2 pool games to determine playoff seeds. Each team plays 2 playoff bracket games to determine final places
- Mens 40+: 8 teams, 2 pools. Each team plays 2 pool games to determine playoff seeds.
 Each team plays 2 playoff bracket games to determine final places
- Mens 45+ Gold: 6 teams, 2 pools of 3 teams. All teams will play 2 pool games to determine playoff standings. Top 2 teams from each pool make the 1-4th playoffs; 5 & 6 seed play one another, and then play the Semi final losers for final game.
- Mens 45+ Silver: 15 teams, 4 pools (3, 4, 4, 4 teams). Pools B, C and D are pool brackets. Each team will play 2 games to determine seeding for playoff round. Playoff brackets will be the following:
 - 1st-4th Place: Pool A 1st, Pool B, C and D bracket winners; 5th-8th Place: Pool A 2nd, Pool B, C, and D bracket runner ups; 9th-12th Place: PA 3rd, 3rd place from each Bracket, 13-15 are bottom seeds from each bracket pool
- Mens 50+: 16 teams, 4 pools of 4, standard bracket play. Each team will play 4 bracket games to determine final standings.
- Mens 55+: 14 teams, 4 pools. Pools A & B are pool brackets. Each team will play 2
 games to determine seeding for playoff round. Playoff brackets will be the following:
 - o 1st-4th Place: PD 1st, PC 1st, Bracket Winner G4, Bracket Winner G8
 - o 5th-8th Place: PD 2nd, PC 2nd, Reseed 7th overall, Reseed 8th overall
 - 9th-14th Place: PD 3rd, PC 3rd, Reseed 9th overall, Reseed 10th overall, Bracket Loser G7, Bracket Loser G3
- **Mens 60+:** 8 teams, 2 pools. Each team plays 2 pool games to determine playoff seeds. Each team plays 2 playoff bracket games to determine final places.
- Mens 65+: 7 teams, 2 pools. Pool A is a bracket Pool. Each team plays 2 pool games to determine playoff seeds. Winner of Pool A and Winner of Pool B will automatically advance to 1st-4th Place Playoff Bracket. The remaining 5 teams will be reseeded (3-7). Reseeds 3 and 4 will advance to 1st-4th Place Playoff Bracket and 5, 6 and 7 will advance to 5th-7th Playoff Bracket. All teams will play 2 playoff games.

- **Mens 70+:** 4 teams, 3 gam format all teams compete in pool, top 2 teams rematch for Championship (if they want to)
- Womens Open Gold: 6 teams, 2 pools of 3 teams. All teams will play 2 pool games to determine playoff standings. Top 2 teams from each pool make the 1-4th playoffs; 5 & 6 seed play one another, and then play the Semi final losers for final game.
- Womens Open Silver: 11 teams, 3 pools (3, 4, 4) all teams play (2) pool games; Top seeds from each & the overall 4 seed make Semi finals, seeds 5-8 make consolation bracket; 9 and 10 seeds play and then play the losers of the consolation bracket opening games.
- Womens 25+: 5 teams, 1 pool all teams play one another and best final results win 1st place
- Womens 35+: 4 teams, 3 games to determine top 2 teams to compete for championship, bottom 2 play for consolation.
